



Behavior Therapist Job Description

<u>Direct Supervisors:</u>	Lead Therapist, Program Supervisor
<u>Reports to:</u>	All levels of each client's clinical team (Lead Therapist, Program Supervisor, Regional Director, Clinical Director), All levels of management

<u>Interacts with:</u>	Clients, Client Families, Behavior Therapists, School Personnel, Administrative Staff

Overall Responsibility

- Provide one-to-one behavior intervention services to children with autism and related disorders.

Key Areas of Responsibility

- Attends scheduled sessions and implements one-to-one behavior intervention services with clients and families
- Attends team meetings, relates observations, and demonstrates behavior interventions and programs
- Implements behavior intervention strategies as decided upon in team meetings and/or as directed by a Lead Therapist or Program Supervisor
- Implements program changes as decided upon in team meetings and/or as directed by a Lead Therapist or Program Supervisor
- Receives feedback in a professional manner
- Implements feedback received
- Submits changes in schedule promptly and to appropriate persons
- Documents session times on Sign-In Sheets and Timesheets, and obtain caregiver signatures
- Completes timesheets accurately and completely
- Submits timesheets by deadline

Qualifications

- Enjoy working and playing with children
- Tolerate working with children who may aggress (e.g., hit, kick, spit, scratch)
- Possess the ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds
- Possess the ability to frequently move about and bend down
- Possess the ability to relate and interact professionally with clients and their families
- Write legibly
- Attained a Bachelor's Degree
- Possess a California Driver's License, Proof of Driver's Insurance, and Automobile
- Possess e-mail address and access to internet
- Obtain medical clearance of active Tuberculosis (TB)
- Obtain clearance to work with children by the Department of Justice (DOJ) and the Federal Department of Investigations (FBI) via Livescan Fingerprinting
